General Information

Open Hours:

- OSHC will be open from 7:15am – 6pm.
- Children are required to be signed in and out by an authorised adult.

Food and Drink:

- Please pack a healthy recess, lunch and snacks along with a bottle of water each day.
- Due to the high number of children with life threatening allergies, please do not send foods containing nuts.
- Afternoon snack is served approximately 3:00 - 3:30pm. The menu is available on the noticeboard.

Valuable Items:

- For reasons of fairness, safety and supervision, no spending money is allowed.
- OSHC takes no responsibility for items brought from home including phones, tablets and chrome books.
- Electronic devices are not to be used to contact people outside of OSHC.

Clothing, Footwear and Sun Safety:

- Please ensure appropriate footwear and hat.
- OSHC will provide an SPF 50+ sunscreen. If your child requires a specific type of sunscreen, please supply it.
- Families are asked to apply sunscreen to children prior to arriving at OSHC.

Transport and Safety:

- The bus company we use has seatbelts. All children and educators are required by law to wear them.
- Excursions may include lunch and play at a local park after the programmed activity.
- Risk assessments available at OSHC.
